

RING 1 ~ HICKSTEAD HORSE FEEDS RING

9.30am start:

- 1. BOTTOM HOLE JUMPING**
Riders any age. Horse or pony not to have won 3 or more SJ classes previously. May be led or assisted
- 2. 1ft 6" ABSOLUTE NOVICE JUMPING**
Riders any age. Horse or pony not to have won £10 before 1.1.10
- 3. 60cm HICKSTEAD SJ OF THE YEAR QUALIFIER**
Riders any age. Horse/pony not to have won £30 before 1.1.10
- 4. 70cm HICKSTEAD SJ OF THE YEAR QUALIFIER**
Riders any age. Horse/pony not to have won £30 before 1.1.10
- 5. 75cm HICKSTEAD SJ OF THE YEAR QUALIFIER**
Riders any age. Horse/pony not to have won £50 before 1.1.10
- 6. 90cm HICKSTEAD SJ OF THE YEAR QUALIFIER**
Riders any age. Open to any horse or pony.

Three highest placed riders not already qualified within first 10 will receive a Hickstead Horse Feeds SJ of the Year Qualifier rosette and qualification card for final to be held at the Southern Counties Show

- 12. SHOW RING EXPERIENCE**
For horses/ponies not previously placed 1st in a showing class
- 13. YOUNGSTOCK (RLS Qualifier)**
Open to any horse or pony 3 years & under. Rosette to 'Best Yearling'
- 14. BEST FANCY DRESS** - Exhibits can be ridden or in-hand
- 15. JUNIOR HANDLER**
Handler 16yrs & under. Handlers not to be assisted
- 16. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (RLS Qualifier)**
Hickstead Horse Feeds M&M Championship qualifier
May be split into Small & Large breeds
- 17. BEST PONY (IN-HAND)**
- 18. BEST HORSE (IN-HAND)**

*THE JUDGE WILL TAKE A 30 MINUTE BREAK AFTER CLASS 18
CLASS 19 WILL NOT START BEFORE 12.30PM*

- 19. LEAD REIN PONY (Rules opposite) (RLS Qualifier)**
'Hickstead Horse Feeds Lead Rein Pony of the Year' Qualifier
- 20. LEAD REIN BEST RIDER (Rules opposite)**
'Hickstead Horse Feeds Lead Rein Pony of the Year' Qualifier
- 21. RIDDEN NOVICE**
Open to combinations which have not been placed 1st previously in a showing class
- 22. RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (RLS)**
Hickstead Horse Feeds M&M Championship qualifier
- 23. RIDING HORSE / PONY (Rules opposite) (RLS)**
'Hickstead Feeds Riding Horse/Pony of the Year' Qualifier
- 24. SHOW HUNTER HORSE / PONY (RLS)**
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring at 15hh)
Hickstead Horse Feeds Supreme Hunter qualifier
- 25. RIDDEN COLOURED (RLS)**
Open to piebald, skewbald, palomino, roan and dun

- 7. Cross Poles JUMPING**
Riders may be led or assisted
Combination NOT to have won 3 or more SJ classes previously
- 8. HORSE & GROOM**
Groom to jump fences 1-5 and rider to jump whole course
Same course as Class 7. Medals to 1st place & rosettes 1st – 8th for rider & groom
- 9. 12YRS & UNDER JUMPING (1ft 9" to 2ft")**
Riders may be led – second round against the clock. Horse/Pony any height. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1 January in the current year
- 10. SCURRY JUMPING (2ft / 60cm)**
- 11. 80cm HICKSTEAD SJ OF THE YEAR QUALIFIER**
Riders any age. Open to any horse or pony.

Rosettes 1st – 8th plus 'Specials' & Trophy / Medal / Prize to 1st place. Sash for 1st in all Hickstead Horse Feed qualifiers

LEAD REIN PONY & RIDING HORSE/PONY RULES

'Hickstead Feeds Lead Rein Pony of the Year' Qualifier

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms.
Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1 January in the current year.
To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband. **Highest placed exhibitor not already qualified within first 6** will receive the Hickstead Feeds Lead Rein Pony Qualifier rosette and the **three highest placed exhibitors not already qualified within first 6** will receive a qualification card for Lead Rein Pony of the Year Championship on 19th Sept.
'Hickstead Feeds Riding Horse/Pony of the Year / Supreme Hunter / M&M' Qualifier

Mare or gelding. Ridden exhibits to be 4 years old & over. The **three highest placed exhibitors not already qualified within first 6** will receive a qualification card for the championship to be held on 19th September in Kent.

Passports, Insurance & Disclaimer

All horses/ponies which enter the show ground MUST have a valid equine passport and MUST be properly vaccinated against equine influenza. Please bring your passport with you to the show as you may be required to show it. **All horses/ponies entering the show ground must have appropriate insurance.** All competitors and members of the public enter the show ground at their own risk. The show organisers cannot be held responsible for anything that may happen from any cause or circumstances whatsoever to exhibitors, their servants or any person visiting or attending the show. It shall be considered a condition of entry or admission to the show ground that each person shall hold the show organisers harmless and that they shall indemnify the show organisers against any legal proceedings arising from any such case or circumstance

Show Rules

Riders must wear a correctly fastened (current standard) riding hat at ALL times when mounted.
Children must be supervised at ALL times.
Dogs must be kept on a lead at ALL times. Please clear up after your dog.
Please put all litter in bins provided or take it home with you – please do not leave litter on the ground as the show field is used for animal grazing.
Please do NOT leave horse / ponies tied to horse boxes / trailers unattended.
No cantoring or galloping except in designated warm-up area.
Please ensure all entrances / exits to show ground and arenas are kept clear.
By entering the show ground you are agreeing to abide by the rules of the show.

Royal London Qualifiers

In classes marked (RLS) first, second and third placed horses/ponies will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show in 2010. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 28 days of the qualifying show. No horse registration is required.

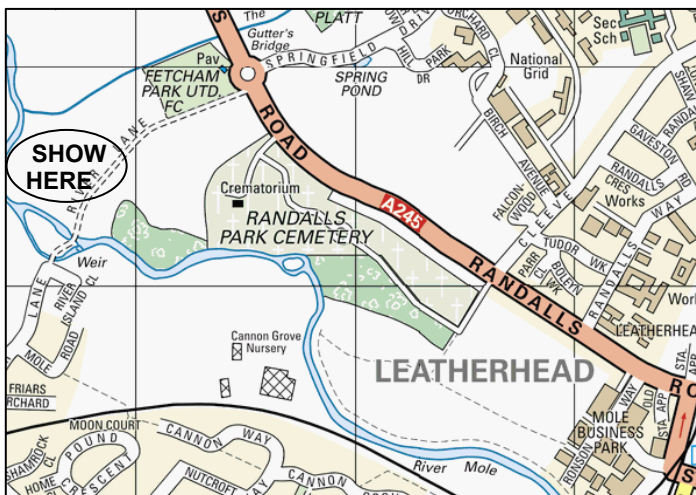
